▲ HOW IT WORKS

We will be climbing the 7-day Machame Route to the top of Mt. Kilimanjaro. Climb Kili has customized this route to 8 days for our group. We promise you'll thank us on the mountain top. There will be an orphanage tour before the climb. Haven of Hope International has partnered with Climb Kili, a respected Kilimanjaro tour operator based in Tanzania.

▲ ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

You will need to arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) no later than two days before the climb (October 4th). Departures can be planned any time on October 14, 2020. We suggest you review your itinerary with our partners Climb Kili.

▲ NEXT STEPS: JOINING THE TEAM

Want to join the team? Here are your **next steps** to start the process

1. Get medical clearance for your participation. Climbing Mt. Kilimanjaro is a strenuous activity over several days. Please check with your doctor prior to applying to ensure you are healthy enough to climb.

2. Apply for a passport. Ensure your passport is valid at least 6 months after your return date. If not, you will likely be denied entrance on your international flight. Visa information: <http://evisa.go.ke/single-entry-visa.html>

3. Register for the climb and any additional activities with Climb Kili. You will need to make a lifetime deposit (\$350) to reserve your spot. Visit climbkili.com/reservations-form/ to make your deposit

4. Sign Waiver. Code of Conduct and Fundraising Agreement upon receipt. Scan and e-mail to stephanie@havenofhopeintl.org or mail original to P.O. BOX 60794, attention: HOHI Climbing for Kids, Fort Myers, FL 33906

5. Set up a time to set up a time to talk about your fundraising options with Stephanie. Stephanie@havenofhopeintl.org

6. Book travel to Mt. Kilimanjaro. We suggest you review your itinerary with Tony Flammia if you have any questions. Tony@havenofhopeintl.org

7. Make a plan to engage your friends, family, church, co-workers, and other supporters so you can meet your goal to help the Futures of Hope program to help change the destiny of orphans around the world.

RELEASE & WAIVER

I, _____ ("Participant") intend to participate in the humanitarian expedition planned by Haven of Hope International to Mt. Kilimanjaro, Tanzania and scheduled to occur in October 2020 ("expedition"). By signing this Release, I hereby acknowledge that I am 18 years or older or will be accompanied by a parent.

I understand that this Expedition carried inherent risks, from inconveniences, to property loss/damage, to serious injury and even death. I also understand that not everything will go as planned. I want to participate in this Expedition and I assume the risk of these things happening.

By signing this Release, I hereby unconditionally, knowingly, and voluntarily agree, on behalf of myself and my heirs, executors, insurers, to the following terms, conditions and policies:

- I waive, release and hold harmless Haven of Hope International (herein after referred to as "HOHI") its executive committee, steering committee, employees, directors, agents, expedition leaders, and all others from all claims, causes of action, damages, costs, fees, personal injuries, death, and other expenses which may arise directly or indirectly from my participation in the Expedition, unless caused by HOHI's gross negligence or reckless conduct. This release includes, without limitation, all rights or claims arising under any applicable state or federal statute, foreign law, international law or any common-law caused of action, including any claims for attorney's fees or other costs. I understand that I am fully responsible for my health before, during, and after the Expedition.
- I understand that I am responsible for consulting with my personal physician prior to the Expedition to ensure that I am healthy and physically capable of participating in the Expedition. I understand that I should also consult with my physician and/or International Travel Office regarding required immunizations.
- I understand that accidents, injuries, illnesses or other occurrence may occur in the course of travel to and from and participation in the Expedition.
- I understand that HOHI is not responsible for payment of any costs, fees, or expenses that may arise as a result of an accident, injury, illness, or other occurrence in the course of travel to and from the participation in the Expedition. I understand that HOHI cannot guarantee that adequate treatment or other care or services are provided, HOHI and those providing treatment and care do so as "Good Samaritans" and with the expectation that they have no legal or other liability as a result of providing such gratuitous services.
- I understand that I am fully responsible for obtaining adequate health, life, disability, and casualty insurance coverage, including evacuation insurance covering my travel to and from and participation in the Expedition. I am also fully responsible for securing any other necessary financial arrangements to provide for any and all costs, fees, damages, or other expenses which may arise as a result of my participation in the Expedition. I understand that HOHI is not responsible for any costs, expenses, fees, or damage to personal property incurred in the course of traveling to or from or participating in the Expedition, including but not limited to loss of baggage, delays or unexpected cancellations.
- I understand that safety is always a concern when traveling and staying in foreign countries. I have read and understand the applicable travel warnings and Consular Information Sheet published by the U.S. Department of State and available at <http://travel.state.gov>. FUNDRAISING AGREEMENT



As part of your participation in the Mt. Kilimanjaro Expedition to Tanzania in 2020, you are committing to raise USD ~~\$2,500~~ ~~\$5,000~~ ~~\$7,500~~ that will provide Futures of Hope Scholarships. Futures of Hope is a vocational sponsorship program that seeks to provide basic tools for success, identify career goals and possibilities, and assist with the transition out of the orphanage and into adulthood, including continuing education and college. This is in addition to the costs for travel (flights, etc.) and outfitting (paid to Climb Kili). You can contribute this amount yourself or you can fundraise among your family, friends, and coworkers.

We have found that including others in your fundraising commitment is a very rewarding and community-building experience, and we encourage you to let others know what you're doing! Haven of Hope International will help you through the fundraising process and provide a personalized fundraising website where you can track online donations and send emails to supporters. We are also available to provide more ideas and support for fundraising along the way.

Ultimately, however, the commitment and responsibility is yours. The commitment helps us plan with confidence for the work we will provide for children and ensure meaningful engagement from each participant in the expedition. You will be required to provide a credit or debit card and it will be automatically charged the difference between the funds raised and your fundraising goal. (The final amount raised will be established on **October 31, 2020**, and the amount charged, if necessary, shortly thereafter.)

Until **August 1, 2020**, if you decide to withdraw from the expedition, you can do so without having the obligation to reach your fundraising commitment. The funds you have raised will still go directly to the mission and you can always join us again in the future. The \$350 Climb Kili deposit is non-refundable but is transferable.

Haven of Hope International requires expedition participants to confirm their spot with a \$100 non-refundable deposit. The \$100 deposit will be credited towards your fundraising goal on your Facebook Fundraising page. It's a great way to show your supporters that you're personally invested in the cause. This is in addition to any deposit for travel and outfitting (Climb Kili).

HOW TO SET UP A FACEBOOK FUNDRAISER



We know the orphan crisis can be overwhelming

But we truly believe that every single person with a desire to make a difference is able to. We wanted to thank you for being willing to support Haven of Hope and the mission to rescue, love, restore, and equip orphans around the world. We are including SIX EASY STEPS to help set up a Facebook fundraiser for your climb.

- 1) Go to your [Facebook](#) account or create a new one!
- 2) Go to your 'home' page, and look on the left side column. You should see the 'fundraiser' option under "Explore" at the bottom. Click on "Fundraiser" and Facebook will walk you through it.
- 3) Scroll down and click on "Select Nonprofit" Type in "Haven of Hope International"
- 4) Set your fundraising goal and start + end date (October 31st)
- 5) Invite people on your friends' list and engage with them! This is key. Invite, invite, invite! Share often on your timeline: remember that not everyone will see something when you post just once. While some people may be hesitant to invite people on their friends list, remember you're giving them an opportunity to participate in something large and global. No problem if they are unable or unwilling to participate at this time – you've at least extended an invitation.
